In 1975, two downtown Lancaster congregations merged to form Church of the Apostles. Their unified goal was to create a campus including a new church, social service agencies, and a Life Plan Community. Planning began in 1976, and the first cottage was completed in 1983.

Today, through the vision and hard work of many, Homestead Village is recognized for the high quality of its accommodations and care. Now an independent, ecumenical nonprofit organization, Homestead Village is no longer affiliated with Church of the Apostles. However, our common mission of serving seniors has created a lasting bond between our organizations.









4 Simple Steps Toward the Life You Deserve

1. Schedule a Visit

A visit to our campus is, by far, the best way to learn about the many advantages of life at Homestead Village.

2. Join the Priority List

Since demand for homes often exceeds availability, Homestead Village maintains a Priority List for future residents. With an initial deposit, you will be assigned a Priority List number, which will be used to determine the sequence in which offers are made as homes become available. Preliminary financial information will be requested.

3. Reserve Your Choice


Once you are offered and accept a specific home, a deposit of 10 percent of the entrance fee will reserve your choice for three months. Within that period, the home will be renovated, and you will complete an application form, a financial statement, and a physical form.

4. Get Ready to Move in!

Two weeks prior to your move-in-date, you will pay your entrance fee balance and sign the Residence and Care Agreement. Your monthly fee will begin when you receive your keys.
