May Is MOMories Month

Anna Marie Jarvis was the founder of the Mother's Day holiday in the United States. Her mother had frequently expressed a desire for the establishment of such a holiday, and after her mother's death, Jarvis led the movement for the commemoration. However, as the years passed, Jarvis grew disenchanted with the growing commercialization of the observation (she herself did not profit from the day) and even attempted to have Mother's Day rescinded. She died in a sanitarium, her medical bills paid by the floral and greeting industries.

In 1914, President Woodrow Wilson issued a presidential proclamation that officially established the first national Mother's Day holiday to celebrate America's mothers.

Many individual states celebrated Mother's Day by 1911, but not until

Wilson lobbied Congress in 1919 that Mother's Day was officially set on the second Sunday of every May. In his first Mother's Day proclamation, Wilson stated that the holiday offered a chance to 'publicly express our love and reverence for the mothers of our country.'

Amazing Grace

Prior to our move to Florida in the summer of 2014, my husband (Dave) and I lived in Virginia, and my parents in Missouri. After years of frequent travel back and forth, it finally became too hard for me to take care of them from such a distance, especially after Daddy's stroke, and Mom's blindness which had already stolen most ofher independence. As their condition reached a crisis point, a whirlwind trip to our favorite state (Florida) convinced us to settle here. Dave retired from the military and we accomplished two major moves within a month's time, ours to our new home in Indian River Colony Club, and my parents to their new home at The Brennity of Melbourne. I was grateful that The Brennity offered a way to keep my parents together, and I'll forever be grateful they could remain together until Daddy passed in 2016.

Many have heard Mom's story about my heart surgery at the age of 2. Though PDA is now an easily treatable condition, back in those days it meant a 50/50 chance of even surviving the surgery. Our extended family was against it, fearful I wouldn't live through it. It wasn't until a surgeon said he wouldn't give 2 cents for my life beyond the age of 16 that my parents decided to do it, even if it meant going it alone and not telling

the family so to prevent them from worry.

The part of the story Mom most remembers is how it felt handing me off to the surgical nurse that morning, with my arms outstretched to her as that nurse carried me away. Would that fearful look and need for comfort be her last memory of me? Well, thankfully, it wasn't. Yet not long thereafter Mom began experiencing heart pains of her own. 'Sympathy pains' was the simplified diagnosis, an analysis very telling of the relationship she and I would forever have with one another. It was a relationship that started even before I was born, when Mom so desperately wanted us to share the same birthdays that she spent her own birthday executing a series of squat exercises; not an easy feat for a little woman with an almost 9-pound baby! Though I wasn't born until 3 days later, we have celebrated our birthdays together ever since.

of many miracles God has performed in my life. Endless

are the stories I have written about my blessings, many of which in recent years have included my appreciation for all who have taken part in my journey as caregiver. When we moved everyone to Florida 5 years ago, I could not have imagined the caregiving 'family' we would inherit here; from the patience and tender loving care of the nurses and CNAs; to the upbeat lifestyles workers and their entertainers who strive to keep a happy environment; to the tireless efforts of the dining room staff who try to please a variety of tastes; to the supportive concierges, and willing maintenance staff, and friendly physical therapists; even to the residents themselves. And time would fail me to tell of the best doctor, and the most awesome Hospice support team in the world; not to mention Mom's personal caregivers-well, books have already been written about them. Though many among these supportive teams have come and gone, many friendships

have yet remained, and will remain.

The love we have received in this place has been more than anything I could have imagined, or hoped for. Many affectionately call my mother Amazing Grace, and it makes my heart sing that song every time I hear it. Not only is she amazing to me, she is a great teacher, for the lessons I've learned as her daughter are incalculable. Besides giving me life itself, probably the greatest gift she ever gave me were her prayers that my faith and hunger for the Lord would become

strong. Surely every miracle in my life can, in some way, be attributed to those prayers.

As time has passed, I have learned how Mom must have felt that day the surgical nurse took me away. Often, I have felt similarly while trying to say goodbye after one of our visits. I felt it intensely last year after she broke her hip, when the hospital medications and change in environment exacerbated her confusions. The scenario of my heart surgery at the age of 2 was reversed as her arms reached out in desperation for me when the x-ray technician wheeled her away. Amazingly, she pulled through that calamitous situation. And she is still going strong.

In April of this year, Mom turned 95, and as tradition Surviving my heart surgery at the age of 2 was only one goes, we celebrated our birthdays together. What a privilege it is, being able to give back a fraction of all she has given me.

- This was just one example of the many times our associates pull together.




